



Check the list..is something missing???

Before leaving home or the hotel, check if you have all of these:

- documents to get the bib number
- proper clothes to race (suitable for the weather conditions!)
- dry clothes to get changed after the race



How to reach Jesolo

Leave with the right advance; if it will be a beautiful day, many people will come to the sea and you could find a queue!!!

CAUTION!!!! From 6.00 am on Sunday 15th September the roads affected by the race course will be closed and you will have difficulty reaching the starting area.

BY CAR

FROM MILAN

Take the A4 motorway towards Venice. After the Mestre barrier, follow the signs for the "Marco Polo" airport and then for Jesolo.

FROM BRENNERO

Take the A22 motorway towards Verona, then the A4 motorway towards Venice. After the Mestre barrier, follow the indications for Marco Polo airport, then those for Jesolo.

FROM TARVISIO

Take the A23 motorway towards Udine, then the A4 motorway towards Venice. Exit at Noventa di Piave / San Donà di Piave, then follow the directions for Jesolo.

FROM TRIESTE AND UDINE

Take the A4 motorway towards Venice. Exit at Noventa di Piave / San Donà di Piave, then follow the directions for Jesolo. Once in Jesolo, follow the signs for Piazza Milano.

BY TRAIN

The nearest train stations are Venice-Mestre 40 km away or San Donà di Piave only 25 km away. To reach Lido di Jesolo take line 10a if you are leaving Mestre while the 19th is arriving from San Donà. Once in the bus station you can take bus number 2 which will take you directly to Piazza Milano.

How to reach Jesolo

BY PLANE

FROM VENICE (MARCO POLO)

Arriving from Venice's "Marco Polo" airport can take line [10a](#) towards Jesolo.

FROM TREVISO (ANTONIO CANOVA)

For those arriving from Treviso airport "Antonio Canova" can take the [JESOLO EXPRESS](#) bus to get to the city; then take [line 108](#) for Lido di Jesolo.

Arrived at the bus station in Jesolo, take bus [number 2](#) to get to Piazza Milano; if you prefer to walk, Piazza Milano is about 3km away.

BY WATER BUS FROM VENICE

From Venice take [lines 12, 14 or 15](#) with Punta Sabbioni last stop. Then take bus [number 23a](#) to get to the Jesolo bus station. Once on site, take bus [number 2](#) to get to Piazza Milano.

Bib numbers and race kit picking up

The bibs will be delivered at the General Accreditation Center in front of the "A. Picchi" Stadium from 9 am to 7 pm every day until Saturday 14th.

Sunday 15 September it will not be possible to collect the bibs.



Toilets

Inside the Grifone Park, numerous bathrooms will be available for all athletes. Respect the territory that hosts us and uses chemical toilets, not the walls of houses!



Personal kit service

The bags must be delivered to the special area set up inside the Parco Grifone. You can deposit your bag starting at 8 am.

Start

Starting times are scheduled at **9am (10km)** and at **09.30am (Half Marathon)** on **Sunday 15 September from Jesolo - Via Danimarca**. Changing rooms and toilets will be available inside the Parco Grifone, adjacent to the start.



Refreshments and sponges

Along the way you will find refreshment points with water, supplements, fruit and biscuits every 5km, starting at km 5. Furthermore, starting at km 7.5, always every 5km, you will find sponging points.



Do not mess it up!!! - WE RELY ON YOU!

To preserve the territory we ask you not to throw away the waste, bottles, glasses and waste paper, but to deposit them near the special containers.



In case of withdrawal

If you experience any problems during the race or are forced to retire, do not panic; we have set up a "broom bus" service, ambulances and medical motorcycles that will follow the race, assist you and in case they take you to the first aid point.



After the finish

The arrival is located in **Jesolo in Via Danimarca**. Inside the Grifone Park you will find the final refreshment, the collection area of the bags with personal clothing and the changing area with the toilets.



Shower service - Picchi stadium

You will be able to use the showers of the "A. Picchi" Stadium using the urban ATVO bus service free of charge up to the station in front of the stadium.



Award ceremony

Don't run away after the race! The awards will take place in Piazza Milano from 12.30. For the half marathon valid for the European Championship the first 3 athletes and teams in each category will be awarded, while for the 10km only the first 3 athletes in each category will be awarded. For the open competitions, the first 3 absolute M/W will be awarded.
